Counterfeit pills often contain fentanyl and can be deadly.

Many counterfeit pills are made to look like prescriptions such as Oxycontin, Percocet, Vicodin, Xanax, or Adderall.

THE FACTS:

- Overdoses involving fentanyl have spiked in Eastern Oregon.
- No one is immune. This danger affects every community.
- You can't smell or taste fentanyl.
- It greatly increases your risk for overdose and death.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

Talk to your loved ones. Educate your children, friends, and family on the danger. Any counterfeit pills or illicit drugs may be laced with fentanyl.

Tell them not to take random pills.

Assume that any "prescription" pill bought outside of normal channels is fake, and very possibly deadly.

Know how to help.

If you find someone who may have overdosed, call 911. Carrying and
